- Technology the varied and evolving technological approaches to the problem points to strong demand for investments in human capabilities, systems and technologies across many different sectors
- Finance how the various parties in the financial ecosystem, from banks and insurers to asset owners and managers as well as public sector entities, can play their role in supporting climate finance

This will be followed by a session by the Hong Kong Stock Exchange on the latest developments in ESG disclosure requirements globally and also under the listing rules. Observations on how the financial industry is complying with the ESG disclosure requirements will also be shared.
