## Programme Outline

In order to enhance the cyber resilience of the banking sector, HKMA has announced that authorized institutions in Hong Kong will be mandated to complete the Cyber Resilience Assessments. As a result, there will be a higher demand for cybersecurity professionals with iCAST required qualifications in Hong Kong, who are capable of conducting cyber resilience assessments and simulation tests.

This briefing session aims to provide an overview regarding this cybersecurity certification, which is recognized locally and internationally by both the Hong Kong Institute of Bankers (HKIB) and Council of Registered Ethical Security Testers (CREST) in the United Kingdom.

These programmes are the first iCAST-oriented cybersecurity training in Hong Kong conducted by CREST approved training providers.
