- Discover the best approach, as well as common mistakes and points to note on the examination. The assessor is responsible for managing the assessment of CCASP/CREST examination (CRT, CCT Infrastructure, CCT Web Applications, CCSAS).
- Get the chance to ask the assessor questions about the examination. The assessor will be able to provide feedback to help candidates prepare for the examination.
- Identify examples and technical knowledge needed to support the examination

It would be appreciated if candidates could note down questions in advance and send them to HKIB. This is so that the assessor can prepare answers and will be able to explain in as much detail as possible during the session.

*CREST operates a small network of Assessors drawn from CREST Member Companies to manage the examination process. The examination process includes collectively devising syllabus content, invigilating, marking and generally operating the exam environment on behalf of CREST.*
