ESG is a corporate governance and investment framework at its core. Companies that adopt ESG principles should consider, measure, report, work on, and improve on their business's environmental, social, and governance aspects alongside financial considerations. ESG investors should also consider a company's ESG attributes alongside their financial attributes when making investment decisions.

RWP

ESG investing is a growing and rapidly developing priority for investors, asset managers and portfolio companies who are considering the social and environmental impact of their investment activities. Emerging ESG trends and issues affect the way that asset managers think about investment objectives, methodologies, processes, performance, and disclosure. Understanding legal, regulatory, market and business requirements that apply to ESG is crucial for not just legal and compliance professionals but also other business personnel.

For Banks, associating COVID with ESG risks is highly appropriate -Banks should have frameworks for operational resilience that are designed not only to preserve business continuity but also to enable organisations to adjust to changing conditions permanently.
