The duties of a MLRO may involve serious legal consequences that result in a civil and criminal action. To mitigate the risks, MLROs must participate in designing AML policies and procedures, ensuring proper on-boarding and ongoing due diligence is performed, investigating and filing suspicious reports, and record-keeping.
