Programme Outline

The course titled "The Corporate Journey to Net Zero and the Role of the Bank" equips participants with a practical understanding of how to translate Net Zero commitments into strategic and operational actions and the crucial role of financing. The session begins by framing the global Net Zero context and key frameworks, followed by guidance on setting credible targets across scopes 1, 2, and 3 emissions. Participants will explore core abatement strategies and sector-specific pathways and corresponding financing approaches. The session concludes with a discussion on the global outlook and implications for Asia Pacific.

Speaker Introduction

The speaker holds a PhD in Renewable Energy Management and master's degrees in international management and accounting and finance from the University of St. Gallen and the London School of Economics. He serves as a Senior Lecturer at the University of St. Gallen and HKUST and is a lecturer in other sustainability executive education programmes and MBA modules focusing on climate change related topics. Outside of academia, he consults companies on their net zero journey, previously in the role of Director of Climate & Sustainability at Deloitte Hong Kong.
