

Affiliate Designation – CB Affiliate and ECF Affiliate

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who are eligible for the Affiliate Designation?

The following categories of individuals are eligible for the Affiliate Designation:

- Non-current Relevant Practitioners in the banking industry (as defined by the HKMA) including but not limited to:
 - *Full-time post-secondary students*
 - *Current banking practitioners in non-relevant job roles*
 - *Practitioners in non-banking fields*
- Current Relevant Practitioners in the banking industry (as defined by the HKMA) who do not possess sufficient relevant working experience for certification requirements.

2. How can I apply for the Affiliate Designation?

Learners who have successfully completed any HKIB CB or ECF programme **will automatically be granted** the designation of “CB Affiliate” or “ECF Affiliate” respectively. No separate application is required.

For holders of HKIB Programme Diplomas or Certificates:

- **Awarded between January 2024 and July 2025:** The Affiliate Designation has been granted automatically by the end of August 2025.
- **Awarded before January 2024:** A formal application is required.

3. What is the fee for the Affiliate Designation?

4. Is renewal required for the Affiliate Designation?

Renewal requirements vary depending on your membership status:

- **Ordinary Members**

To renew your Affiliate Designation(s), you must:

- Accumulate a minimum of **3 HKIB CPD hours** in the previous calendar year.
- Pay the **annual Affiliate certification renewal fee**.

***Note:** Full-time students are exempt from the certification fee until 31 December of their graduation year.*

- **Professional Members**

To maintain your designation(s), you must:

- Submit a **CPD declaration**.
- Pay the **annual PQ certification renewal fee**.

5. I have completed the HKIB CB/ECF programme and received the Programme Diploma/Certificate. When will I receive the Affiliate Scroll?

If you completed the HKIB CB/ECF programme and were awarded the Programme Diploma/Certificate during January 2024 to July 2025, you would receive the corresponding Affiliate Designations by the **end of August 2025**. You will also be **listed in the Registers of Certified Individuals (CI)** and **receive a digital Affiliate Scroll** by that time.

From **August 2025 onwards**, upon completion of the HKIB CB/ECF programme, you will receive the Affiliate Designation within **one month** of the completion of the Professional Qualification Programme Diploma / Certificate.

6. If I was a default Professional Member, can I entitle the Affiliate designation?

If you were a default Professional Member, we strongly encourage you to reinstate your Professional Membership and existing Professional Qualification(s). To do so, please first settle a reinstatement fee of HKD2,000. Once your membership has been reinstated, your existing PQ(s) can be reverted by paying the PQ certification renewal fee and fulfilling the applicable CPD requirement. If you have not yet met the CPD requirement, you may renew your membership as an Ordinary Member in order to maintain your HKIB membership.

With a current and valid membership status, any new diplomas or certificates obtained through completion of the training and examination of CB/ECF programmes, the corresponding Affiliate designation for these programmes will be granted automatically.

7. As an Affiliate Designation holder, how can I progress to become a Professional Qualification (PQ) holder?

Once you have fulfilled the outstanding requirements, such as obtaining Relevant Practitioner status or acquiring sufficient relevant work experience, you may apply to articulate to a CB or ECF Professional Qualification holder.

8. How are the CB/ECF Affiliate Designations recognised by regulators and banks?

Similar to CB/ECF Professional Qualifications, the Affiliate Designations are well recognised by both regulators and banks. These designations are awarded to encourage practitioners to continue their professional development through reskilling or upskilling, in line with regulatory guidance. This initiative supports the ongoing development of talent and contributes to the sustainable growth of the banking industry.

9. Do the required three HKIB CPD hours have to be earned through HKIB activities only?

No. As an Affiliate Designation holder, you can fulfil the three HKIB CPD hours requirement through a variety of activities, not limited to those organised by HKIB. Eligible activities include, but are not limited to:

- CPD/CPT courses organised by other recognised professional bodies.
- Academic studies, such as local or overseas bachelor's or postgraduate degrees in disciplines relevant to the scope of qualified CPD activities.

10. How can the public or HR professionals verify my status as an Affiliate Designation Holder?

The public and HR professionals can verify your Affiliate Designation through the following platforms:

11. I am currently a Student Member. If I am granted the Affiliate Designation and become an Ordinary Member, will I still be entitled to Student Member benefits?

Yes. If you are a full-time student, you will continue to enjoy Ordinary Member benefits while also remaining eligible for Student Member privileges until graduation year. These include, but are not limited to, discounted rates for enrolling in HKIB PQP training and examination. For full details, please refer to the Benefits & Services on our website.
