There are two types of professional programmes providing common qualification benchmark that is recognised by the regulators and the industry.

Professional Qualification Programmes

- **Certified Banker (CB)** designed for banking practitioners aiming to acquire general and all-round banking knowledge
- Enhanced Competency Framework (ECF) Programmes designed for banking practitioners to equip themselves with industry-recognised competencies in specialised areas

The following professional qualification programmes are customised for participants under the Banking Talent Programme working in different banking functions as an entry-level practitioner for the first 6 months. This gives the programme participants a step ahead in fulfilling regulatory, industry requirements and expectations. Once the training is completed and the examination passed, participants will be awarded an industry-recognised certificate or diploma.
