

## **Overview**

HKIB has arranged a new series of **free membership events for networking and knowledge update**. Mai Po Nature Reserve Visiting will be held on **18 March 2023 (Saturday)**.

Known as Hong Kong's "Bird Paradise," Mai Po Nature Reserve has been managed by WWF-Hong Kong since 1983. In 1995, the reserve and the Inner Deep Bay wetlands were recognised as a Wetland of International Importance under the Ramsar Convention. Visiting to Mai Po can experience nature first-hand, enriching the knowledge of Hong Kong's natural environment and sustainable development.

Together with the WWF global finance practice, WWF-Hong Kong engaged with institutional investors, lenders, underwriters, and finance sector influencers in Hong Kong and Asia-Pacific to improve the integration of environmental risks and opportunities, guiding their decisions and actions taken to contribute to environmental and conservation outcomes.
