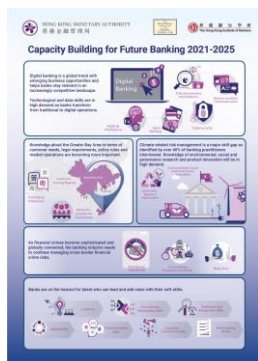
Bridging the Talent Gaps for Future Banking Talent
