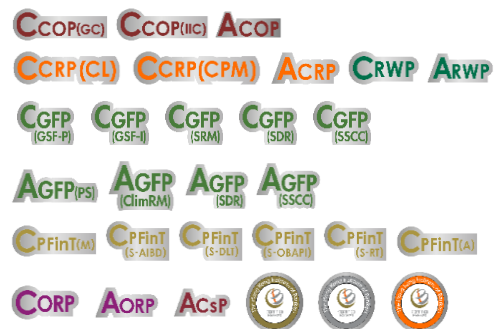
Speaker Introduction
