Programme Outline

This session provides an in-depth exploration of the intersection between finance, sustainability and climate action. Participants will gain an understanding of the latest developments around green and transition taxonomies – reflecting also on the development in Hong Kong – and how those taxonomies can help accelerate the journey towards Net Zero. In a second part, the session also explores the corresponding low-carbon solutions, identifying the most promising investment opportunities across the greentech ecosystem.
