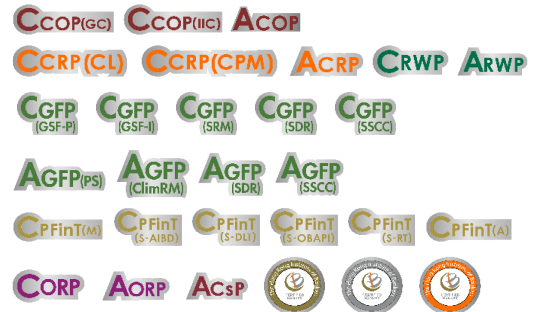
## Speaker Introduction
