Programme Outline

Physical climate risks already affect Hong Kong banking. New HKMA adaptation regulations create urgency, yet industry capability gaps remain. This course helps bankers assess, structure and finance resilience while avoiding adaptation-washing risks.

1. Explain why climate adaptation and physical risk have moved to the center of Hong Kong's sustainable finance agenda, including the HKMA Taxonomy Phase 2A adaptation objective and the Cross-Agency Steering Group's 2026–2028 priorities.
2. Identify how acute and chronic physical hazards — flood, water stress, heat and storm — transmit into credit, collateral and portfolio risk for Hong Kong and Greater Bay Area clients.
3. Apply the 4R Framework (Recognise, Rate, Respond, Reward) to assess a client's physical exposure and identify credible, financeable resilience measures.
4. Distinguish genuine adaptation finance from “adaptation-washing”, using the Taxonomy's screening logic and a realistic view of the current resilience-finance market.
5. Recognise the instruments and structuring options for financing resilience — and their present limitations — in order to spot origination opportunities ahead of regulatory expectations.

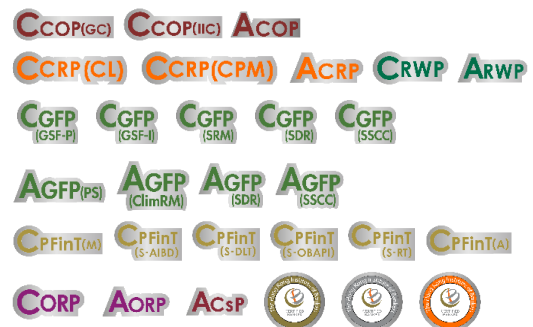
Speaker Introduction
