- Develop important insights into the latest global sustainable market, and evaluate their impact on future opportunities for banks in the GBA

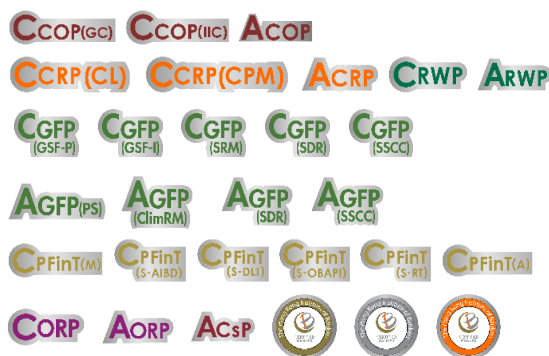
Speaker Introduction
